

Did You Know?....

- After August 1964 all Mustangs came equipped with a standard energy efficient alternator instead of a generator.
- The Mustang II designs were based on the Ford Pinto.
- The High Country Special Mustang collection were designed with their own color scheme to depict the colors prominent in the Rocky Mountains area and were marketed in New Mexico, Colorado and Nebraska territories.
- 1974 was the first year of the Mustang Hatchback.
- Between 1965 – 1967 only 348,427 Cobras were produced. Today these cars are worth approximately \$1 million a piece.
- The lowest rated engine in a Mustang was the 2.3L with 88 hp @ 5000 rpm.
- In 1966, Hertz Rent-a-Car purchased 1,000 GT 350 H models to be used in their fleet. This program was often called the “Hertz Rent-a-Racer”.
