

## Feature Car of the Month:

Dan's '65 Fastback was salvaged after sitting for 15 years in an open shed. Filled with mice, locked brakes, #1 cylinder with the spark plug missing, paint peeling and flat tires. The restoration started by hand stripping, sanding and priming one section at a time. The interior was completely removed and replaced. The car received new brakes, headers, exhaust, tires, seat covers, carpet, headliner, dash and controls. Parts were saved and reused where possible. The Boss 302 engine was rebuilt with a Holley 850 CFM carburetor and mated to a Hurst shifted 4 speed transmission. The engine combo is good for around 420 horse power. Out back the rear is outfitted with 4.86:1 gearing and traction bars. The body was painted Metallic Copper. The project was completed in 2006 after 3 years of labor. The Fastback spends a quiet life now in retirement. Nice work Dan. I know that you must proud of the finished project. This is one hot pony.
