Next was the 1971 Roadrunner. This car seemed to give the Mustangs a bad time with 314 hp to the wheels.



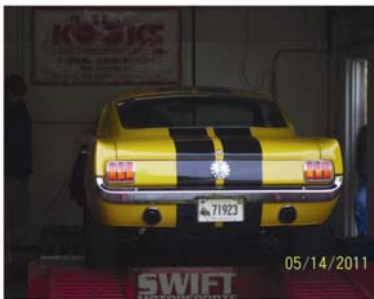
Jeff Watterson's 2002 GT went on to show 246 hp to the wheels.



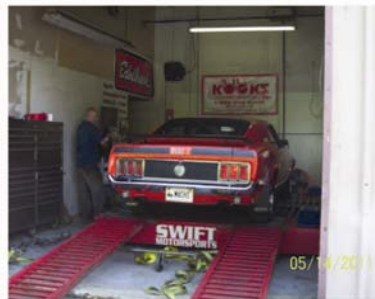
Brian Gran's 2009 Shelby GT500 was amazing at 498.4 hp straight from Ford!! There are more modifications in the future I'm sure.



Jim Fletcher with his 1966 Coupe drove away with 167 hp to the wheels. There may be some tweaking in the future here as well.



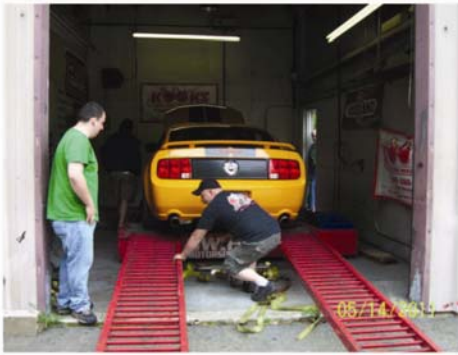
Duke Miller brought this 1965 Fastback back to life a few years ago. He did an awesome job and was rewarded with pulling out 318.6 hp as a result of his work.
